The Steamboat Jubilee Mountain Official Community Plan (OCP) process is underway. Introductory meetings were held in July to introduce the project and highlight some of the proposed policy areas such as the introduction of Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA) Development Permits and revitalization of the Edgewater commercial core.

Since July, a great deal of work has been undertaken by Planner Michele Bates including numerous meetings with various stakeholders throughout the plan area. These meetings will continue into 2020.
