

Audia Road - Rosen Lake Community Debris Bin Event

April 27 - May 11

The East Kootenay FireSmart™ Program will hold a Community Debris Bin Event on Audia Road in Rosen Lake, starting on April 27. This event is only for residents on Audia Road to dispose of yard waste.

The bin will be located at the end of Audia Road from April 27 - May 11.

Some tips for cleaning up your home and property:

- Be sure to clean gutters and roofs.
- Clear under decks and other enclosed spaces.
- Remove smaller coniferous trees that could act as a “ladder” and allow fire to move into the treetops.
- Clean up woody debris on the ground.
- Remove branches within 2 metres of the ground.
- Prune dead branches.

Accepted:

- ✓ Tree limbs up to 5” diameter
- ✓ Brush
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Grass Trimmings
- ✓ Weeds/Needles

Not Accepted:

- ✗ Construction Materials
- ✗ Treated Wood
- ✗ Disposal Materials
- ✗ Root Balls
- ✗ Tree limbs over 5” in diameter

Important things to remember:

- The use of the debris bin is limited to those residents living within the neighbourhood hosting the event.
- Champions must monitor the state of their bins and the RDEK requires minimum 72 hours’ notice for bin replacement. Bin replacement cannot be done on weekends.
- Bin events are meant to facilitate the FireSmarting of Home Ignition Zones surrounding pre-existing homes.
